#### ***"How Long?"***

*What's a Christian to do  
when the going gets tough?*

#### **Is it wrong to complain?**

**No, David lamented long and loudly (1-2).**

#### **Is it alright to cry?**

**Yes, if you cry to the Lord. David did (3-4).**

**Absolutely, David did and rejoiced (5-6).**

#### **Takeaways:**
