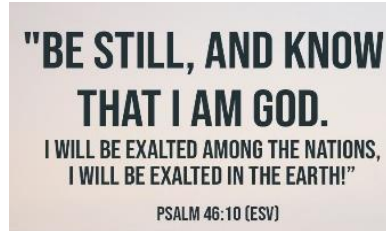


**Our Song of Silence**

**BACKGROUND** of Psalm 46:

- It's a communal psalm.
- It's a psalm of Zion.
- The writer may have been King Hezekiah.
- The occasion may have been 2 Kings 18–19.

**THEME** of Psalm 46:

\_\_\_\_\_ as *our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble* (1)

**RESPONSE** to Psalm 46:

\_\_\_\_\_ - *Therefore we will not fear* (2)

**RESULTS** of Psalm 46:

- Knowing God brings \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ (2–5)
  - No need to fear even \_\_\_\_\_ disasters (2-3)
  - No need to fear because \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ us (4-5)
- Knowing God brings \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ (6–9)
  - No need to fear even \_\_\_\_\_ chaos (6a)

- No need to fear because \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ (6b-7)
- No need to fear because \_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_ (8-9)

**LESSONS** from Psalm 46:

- Rest assured, God will receive all the \_\_\_\_\_ (10–11)
- We are commanded to:
  - Be still – \_\_\_\_\_ to His reign in our world and our lives.
  - Know God – \_\_\_\_\_ His authority and character.
- We should \_\_\_\_\_ of God's power.
